

Emoji Pillows

Material

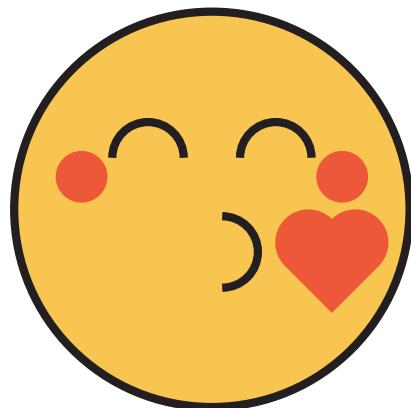
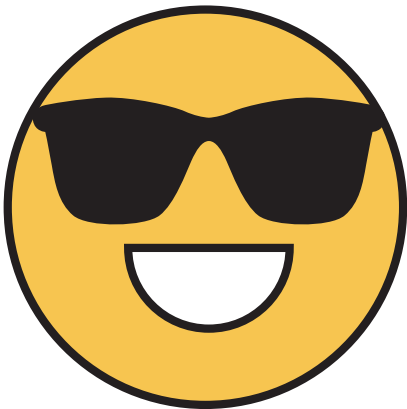
- Minky Yellow
½ yard
- Black
½ yard
- (Optional) White, blue, or red
1 fat quarter of any extra colors you need
- Backing
½ yard
- Batting
½ yard

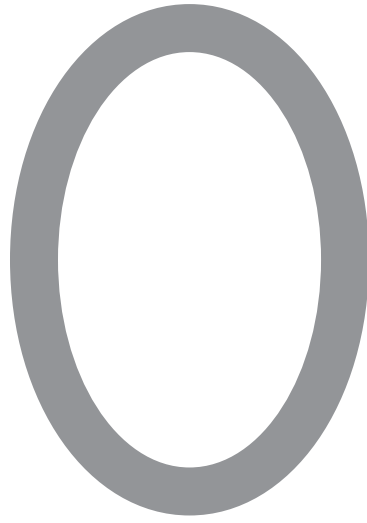
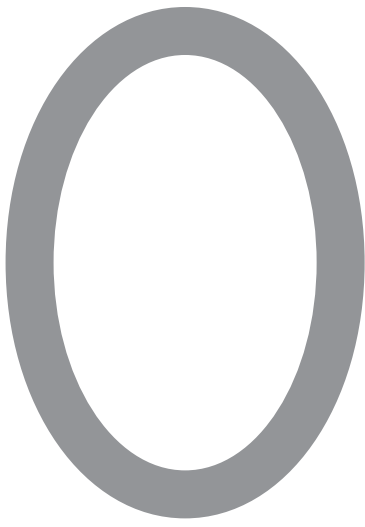
Notes


- Finished size: 12" circle
- WOF=width of fabric
- Use a ¼" seam allowance

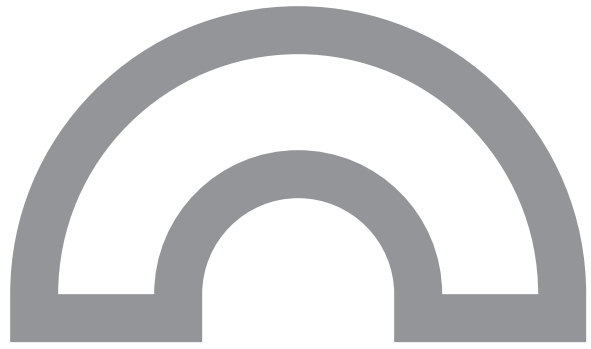
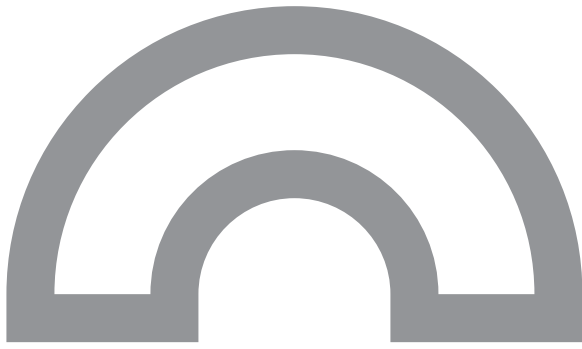
- 1 Cut a circle with a 12½" diameter from the yellow minky fabric.
- 2 Cut some features from the black fabric using the templates. Cut 2 of each shape, stitch along the edges. Cut a hole in the back and flip inside out.
- 3 Attach your backing and batting to your quilting frame.
- 4 Place the circle cut in step 1 on the batting and stitch around the edges of the circle to tack it down.
- 5 Arrange the pieces you cut in step 2 onto the yellow circle. Give some space around the edge of the circle to allow the edges of the pillow to bend.
- 6 Use the machine to stitch down the pieces.
- 7 Remove your quilt sandwich from the frame and cut out the circle with the emoji face.
- 8 Cut a circle with a 12½" diameter from the black fabric and sew to the right side of the emoji face leaving an opening.
- 9 Pull the pillow right side out and stuff through the opening.
- 10 Hand stitch the pillow closed.
