


# **NICE for Santa**



Thank you for joining us on the Tuesday's with Grace platform! Here are the written instructions on how to create the NICE for Santa Quilt.

## Materials

- 41/2 yards of red printed fabric
- $3\frac{1}{2}$  yards of white fabric
- 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yard of gray printed fabric
- 4 yards batting
- 4 yards backing

## Notes


- Finished size: 72" x 62"
- WOF=width of fabric
- Use a ¼" seam allowance

# Cut Your Fabric


- Red fabric
  - 20 squares 81/2"
  - 3 strips 4"x 541/2"
  - 4 strips  $3\frac{1}{2}x$  width of quilt, for the borders
- White fabric
  - 20 squares 81/2"
  - 80 squares 41/2"
  - 4 strips 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"x width of quilt for the borders
- Gray Fabric
  - 6 strips 21/2" x 541/2"

# **Pinwheel Candies**


 Place the right sides of the large white squares and red squares together, and cut 80 half square triangles. Sew ¼" away from all four edges. Then, cut along both diagonals and press open.




 Place a small white square right sides together in the corner of a half square triangle where the two colors meet. Then, sew along the diagonal of the small white square and cut the corner off ¼" away from the seam. Repeat for all 80 half square triangles.




 Place two of the pieces you just made right sides together and the white corner pieces together. Sew along one of the edges opposite the white corners, then press open. Repeat until you have 40 units.



 Place two of the pieces you just made right sides together and the white corner pieces together. Sew along the edge opposite the white corners, then press open. Repeat until you have 20 pinwheel candies.



• Sew five pinwheel candies in a row until you have four rows.




# Assemble Your Quilt

Sew your pinwheel candy rows and strips in this pattern: Candy row, gray strip, red strip, gray strip. Then finish off with a final candy row and cut off any excess fabric from your strips.

Add a white border and then a red border according to the **Assembly Diagram** on the next page.

Attach your quilt-top, batting and backing to your frame and quilt. Use some white minky yarn and the couching foot to add the text as shown on the cover page.
