In this relaxed and exciting class, Pauline will show you how easy it is to strip piece straight onto the backing and batting, so no quilting is needed in the blocks. You will also learn how to join 4 blocks together using one of Pauline's Quilt As You Go (QAYG) methods, creating a star where the blocks join.

## **Requirements for the 4 blocks:**

- 12 fat ¼" s choose a selection of lights, darks and maybe some brights.
- 1 metre (approx. 1.1 yards) of 1.12m wide fabric for backing
- 0.5m (approx. 20") fabric for sashings
- <u>0.4 metres (approx 15.75") Hobbs Double Sided Fusible Batting</u> (the batting on our website is 2.4m wide)
- <u>PQW 12 ½" x 12 ½" Ruler</u>
- QAYG Pieced Sashing Templates 3" Set
- <u>3" Sasher Tool</u>
- QAYG Quilting Templates Set M
- Bohin Fabric Marking Pencil
- Superior MonoPoly clear thread <u>Small Spool</u> or <u>Large Spool</u>
- Normal sewing thread
- Thread for quilting eg. Wonderfil White DecoBob DB104
- <u>Titanium Topstitch Needles size 80/12</u>
- <u>Roxanne Glue-Baste-It</u>
